

That way you can shop from the couch in your PJs. ②) Every Amazon gift certificate you purchase through our Scrip program returns 3% to Bethany's ministry.
- GIVE Amazon Scrip gift certificates as gifts! Amazon carries pretty much anything, so Amazon gift certificates are welcome gifts for pretty much anyone!
- Start your shopping on AmazonSmile.com instead of just Amazon. When you go to AmazonSmile, you can choose Bethany Lutheran Church as an organization you'd like to support. The website looks exactly the same, you'll still use your regular Amazon account, and the prices are exactly the same, but a portion of your purchase is donated to Bethany.
